# Who We Are and What We Want To Do



Some of you will have been at the Launch of Breathing Matters in January 2011. It was an honour to meet over 100 patients and relatives, to hear your stories and discuss ways we can help each other.

Feedback from the Launch was very positive; many patients and relatives had not heard of the work of the Centre for Respiratory Research (CRR) and gained hope by our efforts. Also, many scientists were inspired by meeting the patients whom their work helps.

Breathing Matters is a UCLH Charity fund supporting the CRR in their commitment to find better ways to diagnose and treat pulmonary fibrosis and infection.

Pulmonary fibrosis (PF) is a disease with a poorer prognosis than almost all cancers and for which there is no cure apart from lung transplantation. Many different diseases lead to PF, including rheumatoid arthritis, farmers's lung and asbestos exposure. No-one is sure why, but PF is on the rise and more people are predicted to die from these diseases in the future unless we find a cure.

Bronchiectasis is a disease in which damage to the lungs caused by a variety of conditions including childhood infections or genetic diseases, such as cystic fibrosis resulting in chronic lung infections. Again, lung transplantation is the only cure.

Neither of these diseases are caused by smoking. In contrast to heart disease and cancer, respiratory disease is relatively underfunded and under researched. Breathing Matters wants to change this.

# **BREATHING MATTERS WISH LIST**

- Cryoscopic Extractor and Study: Enabling a study to investigate whether lung biopsies taken via the bronchoscope using cryoscopic extraction, can give the same information as those taken during general anaesthetic and open lung biopsy. If this is the case, cryoscopic biopsy will replace major chest surgery. Better for the patients, safer and less painful. Cost: 25K for equipment, £10K for study.
- PhD Research Fellow to work on IPF in the laboratory for 3 years. Cost: £45K with UCL contributing £45K of matching funds
- An imaging system called Nuance from Caliper Life Sciences. A multispectral imaging system which would facilitate a lung pathologist and research scientist to identify unique abnormalities in lungs from patients with PF. Cost £45K.
